

**NYU in London**  
**Book Sale Spring 2017**  
**FAQs**

- **Who is selling the books?**

Blackwell's bookshop is our official bookseller in London. They bring the books to us for orientation to make it easy for you to buy the right titles. They also run a buyback scheme so they bring some second hand/used copies to the sale and give you the chance to sell back your books at the end of term. After the book sale Blackwell's set up a display of NYU titles in their shop for another 10 days, so you can visit the store at the address below.

- **Do I have to buy my books from them?**

No. We order our books through Blackwell's to make sure as many texts as possible are available to you when you arrive in London. We want you to be as prepared as possible for your classes. However, you are welcome to buy your books wherever you like and can also purchase second hand copies (Blackwell's also bring some second hand copies to their sale).

- **Can I buy my books at another time (what if I drop/add a class, etc)?**

Yes. You can purchase books at another time from the Blackwell's store at 50 High Holborn, London, WC1V 6EP Mon-Fri 8-6.30pm, Sat 10-4pm, Sun closed. Telephone # 020 7292 5100.

- **I have to buy my book from the NYU bookstore. How can I do this? What book will I need?**

Some courses require that you purchase their textbooks from the NYU bookstore (in New York). These classes use books customized and packaged especially for NYU and these customised textbooks are not available in the UK. If this applies to any courses that you are taking then you will have be contacted about this via email.

You can order any book that is in stock either via the website (<http://www.bookstores.nyu.edu/>) or by phone (212-998-4667). They accept Visa, Mastercard, Amex and Discover. The books are typically shipped out the next business day, and they ship UPS. The cost is \$6.00 for the first book and \$1.50 for each additional book, for regular ground shipping. Overseas shipping costs considerably more. Please arrange for your books to be delivered to yourself at the Academic Centre: 6 Bedford Square, London, WC1B 3RA, U.K. You can then collect the books from reception with your ID card.

- **Are the books at the book sale more expensive?**

The book sale is run by Blackwells, a chain store similar to Barnes and Noble and the prices at the book sale are comparable to stores elsewhere. There are occasionally used books available at a discount, but otherwise standard prices will apply. Feel free to come along and compare prices for yourself.

- **I have to buy a course pack. How do I do this?**

You will be contacted by e-mail when your course pack is ready for purchase. You can then submit your order online via the NYU bookstore as above.

- **What if I need to purchase books independently?**

There are a number of bookstores on Charing Cross Road, Waterstone's opposite ULU or online booksellers you can choose, but Blackwell's are the most likely to stock the books you need as we work together to supply them with the reading lists. If you buy online, please arrange for your books to be delivered to yourself at the Academic Centre: 6 Bedford Square, London, WC1B 3RA, U.K. You can then collect the books from reception with your ID card.
